## (XI) FRETILIN Movement - Party ML(I)

- (1) What is FRETILIN?

  It is a movement of liberation of East Timor which unites all patriots and true nationalists, without discrimination as to age, sex, race, creed or ideology, in the struggle against political, economic and cultural colonialism.
- (2) Who are the Maubere people?

  The Maubere people are all those who, by actions, words or in thought declare themselves to be resolutely against the barbarian invader and occupier of our country and who sincerely repudiate colonisalism.
- (3) What is the Front in the Government and vice-versa? The Front is the Government. When we speak of the Government we speak of the Front. The structures of our Government are revolutionary in which the exercise of power belongs to the People, and, through the power of the People, the People in centralised organs elect bodies from the People's Assembly in the villages to the National People's Assembly.
- (4) What is the structure of the Government of the Democratic Republic of Timor (RDTL)
  The Government of the RDTL has the following levels in its structure:
- (a) central organs of power: the People's Assembly, the presidency, the Council of Ministers, the Supreme Court of Justice
- (b) district coordinating bodies
- (c) organs of power of the base (rank and file bodies):
  Assembly of the People, Democratic Revolutionary Councils

- (5) What are Democratic Revolutionary Councils?
  The DRCs are organs of power established in the villages, whose members are elected by the people of the village in universal sufferage, by the representatives of the needs and interests in the villages in higher bodies.
  The DRCs have the job of directing, orienting and solving the problems of the villages.
- (6) What is the Assembly of the People? The Assembly of the People is the highest body for debating and solving the problems of the village for free and democratic discussions.

a privileged minority.

Are all Citizens of East Timor obliged to belong to the Party?

No Entry to the Party obeys the criterion of practicality arising from the interests of the workers and is regulated by complete free will.
